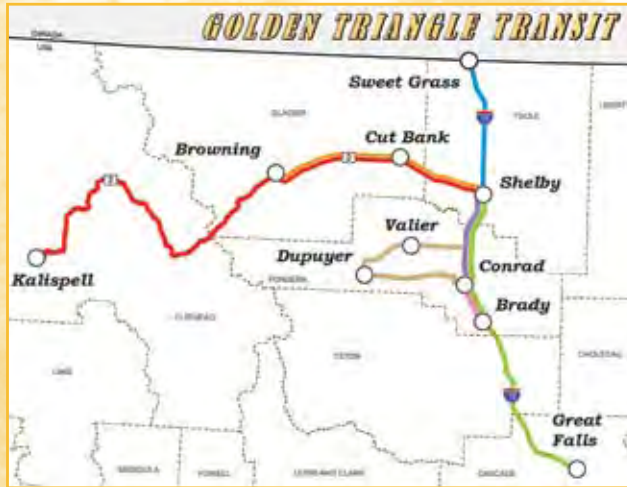

- **Courtesy & Respect from Transit Staff, Including Safe & Reliable Service**

**Riders Are Expected to Show the Following Responsibilities....**

- **Respect for Other Passengers & Public Transit Staff**
- **Obey Vehicle and Service Rules**
- **Be Considerate, Avoid Using Vulgar or Offensive Language**
- **Keep Your Feet on the Floor of the Bus, Not On Seats**
- **Do Not Distribute Literature/Petitions to Others**
- **Keep Hands/Arms Inside the Bus, Not Out the Window**
- **Remain Seated While the Bus is in Motion**
- **Keep from Distracting Driver with Redundant Conversation**
- **Avoid Carrying Hazardous/Flammable Materials, Illegal Drugs, Open Containers of Alcoholic Drinks or Weapons**
- **Do Not Disturb Other Passengers**
- **Deposit Litter in the Trash Receptacle**
